The Northern Club is a place to dress your best.

We ask that Members and guests respect the dress code when visiting the Club. Those who fail to do so may be refused entry. All areas of the Northern Club require a 'smart' style of dress.

## Ivy Bar & Members Dining Room - Formal Business Attire:

- · Men must wear a tailored jacket with collared shirt.
- · Men must wear a tie when dining in the Members Dining Room for dinner.
- · Women must wear formal business attire.
- · No denim.

During the Summer months, Club Management may waive the requirement for a jacket.

## All other areas of the Club, including Bankside Bar & Lounge and The Bistro - **Relaxed Business Attire:**

- · Men should wear a collared shirt; this can be a plain polo shirt.
- · A plain T-shirt can only be worn with a tailored jacket.
- · Women must wear relaxed business attire.
- Denim jeans in a solid colour are permitted; no faded, ripped or distressed jeans.

## The following are NOT permitted in any area of the Club:

- X Sneakers, sport shoes or trainers of any kind.
- X Shorts.
- X Ripped, faded or distressed jeans.
- X Jandals or casual sandals.
- X Sportswear, athletic wear\* and leggings, including hoodies.
- X Baseball caps, beanies or other hats.
- X Sleeveless vests, puffer jackets and casual outerwear.
- X Advertising messages or logos.

\*Sportswear and athletic wear is permitted in the Gym, and when travelling directly to and from the Gym. Members should take the most direct route when entering or leaving the Gym.

We ask that Members make their guests aware of this policy.

Those who technically comply with the dress code,
but still do not appear sufficiently well presented, may be refused entry.

These standards apply to all people entering the Club including guests attending private events.

Specific Club functions may have dress code variations which will be stated in the event information.

Any decision regarding the suitability of a member's or guest's appearance will be at the discretion of Club Management.
